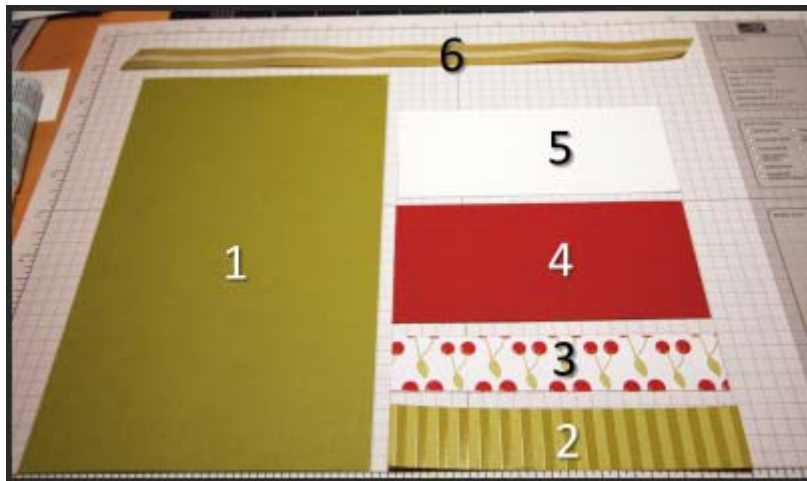

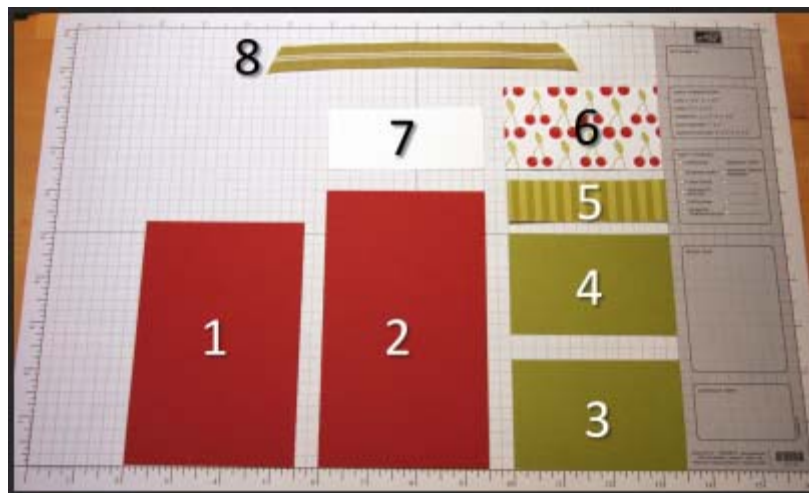

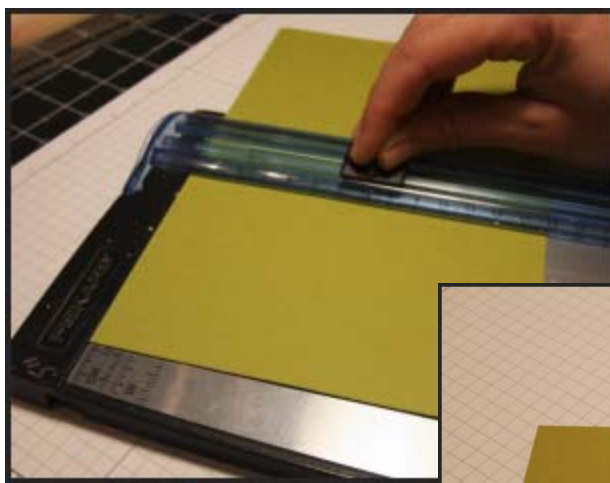


## GIFT CARD "Prep Activities"

For Workshop purposes, the activities below can be completed in any order. Just make sure you complete all of them before assembling your project!

Use the checkbox next to each activity title to ensure you complete each before assembling!

### PREP ACTIVITY 1: SCORING



With the texture side facing down, score the 8 ½ x 5 ½ Kiwi Kiss Textured Card Stock at 4¼ inches.

Fold the card with the texture side out, and use a bone folder along the crease.



## □ PREP ACTIVITY 2: STAMPING



Using the multiple circles stamp from the Circle Circus stamp set, stamp your background image in Riding Hood Red Classic Ink on the 5 ½ x 2 ½ Riding Hood Red Textured Card Stock.

Make sure you stamp on the **textured** side!

**Tip:** When stamping backgrounds, BE RANDOM! There is no “right” or “wrong” way! Do as much or as little as you like!

## □ PREP ACTIVITY 3: PUNCHING

Use the **Eyelet Border punch** along the 5½” edge of the 5 ½ x 2 ¼ Whisper White Card Stock.

**Tip #1:** For the first cut, turn the punch over and align the corner of the card stock with the beginning of the punch design

**Tip #2:** After making the first cut, turn the punch back over and lay it on the table. Slide the cardstock up so that the punched image lines up with the image on the punch. Before you punch again, make sure the images line up AND the card stock is against the top edge of the punch!

Continue punching (keeping Tip #2 in mind) until the entire 5 ½ “ edge has been cut.

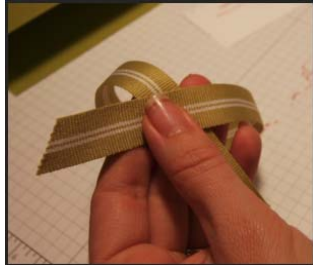


Following the same tips in the step above, punch the 5½ edge of the 5½ x 2½ Riding Hood Red Textured Card Stock using the **Scalloped Edge punch**.

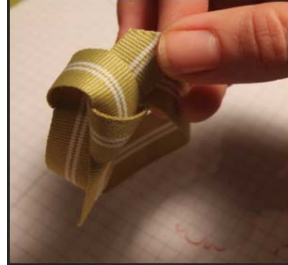
## □ PREP ACTIVITY 4: TIE YOUR RIBBON

Tie the end of the 12” Kiwi Kiss Ribbon into a double knot.

Here are some tips on tying a pretty knot!



Lay the two ends over each other



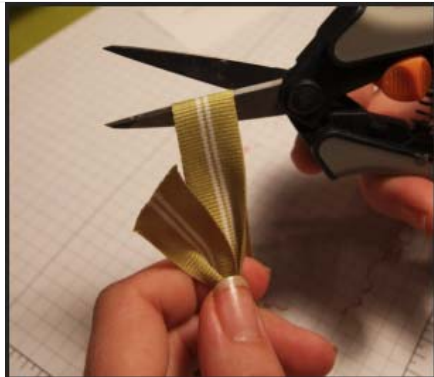
Tie your double knot loosely



Put your middle and ring finger into the main loop and use your forefinger and thumb to slowly pull the ends. Make any adjustments at this time.



When the ends are in the direction you like, and the middle looks nice, pull the ends tight.



Using your scissors, cut about 2” to either side of the knot.

Your finished ribbon should look like so:

You should have about 2” to the right and the remainder (longer piece) to the left.

Trim the hanging edges of the knot to your liking.

**Tip:** If you like, you can burn the edges to prevent fraying, or allow them to fray for a shabby chic look!



## Card Assembly Instructions

*Make sure you have completed all of the prep activities before you begin assembling your project!  
These steps should be completed in this order!*



Grab your piece of whisper white card stock with the eyelet edge.

Using Riding Hood Red Classic Ink, stamp the “Wishing You Happiness” sentiment in the center and **as close to the eyelet edge as possible!**

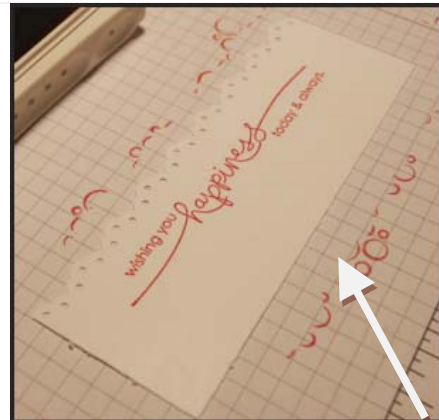
**Tip #1:** Press your stamp firmly into the ink pad 3 or 4 times, making sure that the entire image is inked.

**Tip #2:** Apply firm and steady pressure when stamping. Feel free to use both hands and press down in the middle. Do not rock the stamp!

**Tip #3:** Practice on your placemat!

You should have at least an inch of empty space under your stamped image to make room for the ribbon. If you stamped too low, turn your cardstock over and try again!

If your image isn't “perfect”... GREAT! That's the beauty of handmade art... it should look handmade! ☺



Place a row of Sticky Strip underneath your stamped sentiment.

Use the bone folder and rub over the tape firmly. This will help you to lift off the red covering. And make the tape adhere better.

Remove the red covering.

Apply your tied ribbon over the sticky strip. Try to line up the knot underneath the words, “today & always.”

Turn the card stock over and adhere 2 small pieces of sticky strip to the edges using the same methods described above.

Fold over the ribbon edges after removing the red covering.



Take your folded Kiwi Kiss Card and use the corner rounder punch to round the edges of the card **at the fold** (i.e. the TOP of the card).

Apply SNAIL adhesive to the back of the Green striped Rockabilly Paper and then carefully line it up along the top fold of the card. (Over the area you just punched). Do not press down until you are certain of its placement!

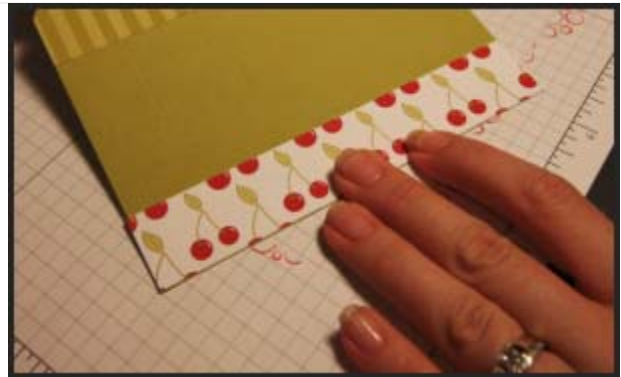




Now punch the same corners of the card with the corner rounder.

*Note: The 2-step punching is just a precaution – if you try to punch too many layers, you can break your punch!*

Apply SNAIL adhesive to the back of the Cherry patterned paper and carefully line up and place it at the **bottom** of the card front.

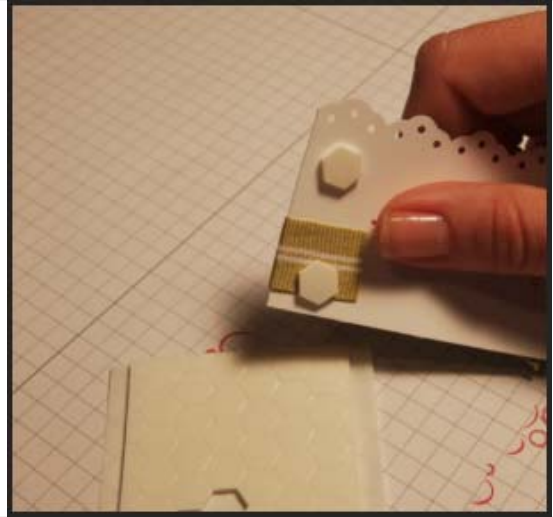


Now take your Scallop punched Riding Hood Red Card stock and apply it using the SNAIL adhesive. Make sure to line the edges up before pressing down. The top edge of the scallop should be about  $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the top of the card.



Apply several Stampin’ Dimensionals to the back of the whisper white cardstock piece. Make sure to place at least one at each corner and 2 in the middle.

**Tip:** Use the tip of your scissors or a paper piercer to remove the backing to the dimensional.



Apply the “popped” whisper white cardstock piece to the front of the card about  $\frac{3}{4}$ ” from the bottom.

VOILA! What a beautiful card you made! 😊

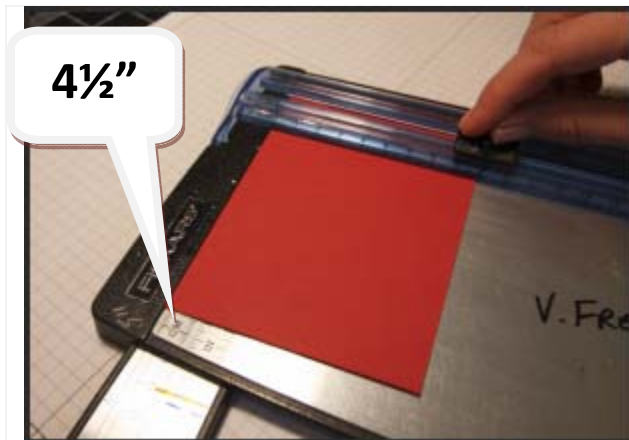
## TREAT BAG “Prep Activities”

For Workshop purposes, the activities below can be completed in any order. Just make sure you do all prep activities before assembling your project!

Use the checkbox next to each activity title to ensure you complete each one before assembling!



### PREP ACTIVITY 1: SCORING



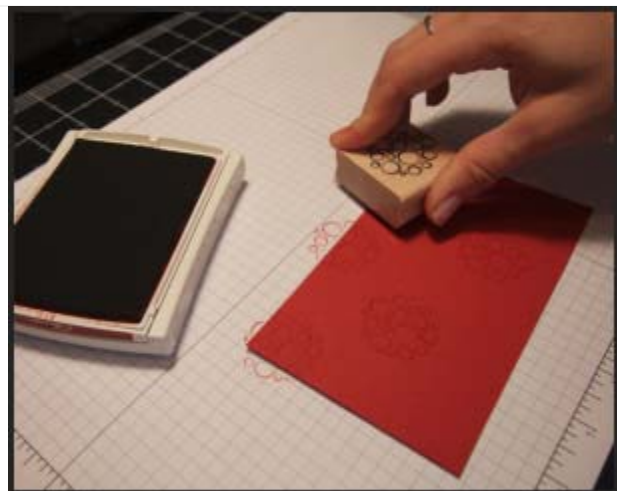
With the texture side facing down, score *both pieces* of Riding Hood Red Textured Card Stock at 4½ inches.

### PREP ACTIVITY 2: STAMPING

Using the multiple circles stamp from the Circle Circus stamp set, stamp your background image in Riding Hood Red Classic Ink on *both pieces* of the Riding Hood Red Textured Card Stock.

Make sure you stamp on the **textured** side!

**Tip:** When stamping backgrounds, BE RANDOM! There is no “right” or “wrong” way! Do as much or as little as you like!



## □ PREP ACTIVITY 3: PUNCHING

Use the **Eyelet Border punch** along the 3½” edge of the 3 ½ x 1½ Whisper White Card Stock.

**Tip #1:** For the first cut, turn the punch over and align the corner of the card stock with the beginning of the punch design

**Tip #2:** After making the first cut, turn the punch back over and lay it on the table. Slide the cardstock up so that the punched image lines up with the image on the punch. Before you punch again, make sure the images line up AND the card stock is against the top edge of the punch!

Continue punching (keeping Tip #2 in mind) until the entire 5 ½ ” edge has been cut.



Following the same tips in the step above, punch the 3½ edge - *furthest from the scored edge* - of the 3½ x 5¼ Riding Hood Red Textured Card Stock using the **Scallop Edge punch**.

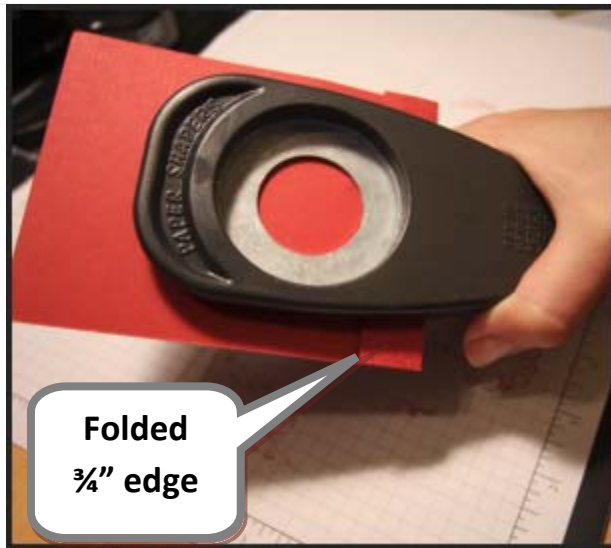
Use the 1¼” punch to punch out a circle in the ***middle*** of one of the 3½ x 2¼ Kiwi Kiss Card Stock Pieces.

**Make sure you are not too close to any of the edges!**



Using the same piece of cardstock, line your punched hole up in the middle of the Scallop Circle punch. When you are happy with the placement, make your cut!

This will create the flower border around the window of the gift bag. Make sure you set this piece aside and don't lose it! 😊



## FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY:

**Note:** *You'll have to complete Activity 1 (Scoring) before completing this step.*

Take your 3½ x 5¼ Riding Hood Red Card Stock and fold up the ¾" flap. (This will be the piece with the scallop edge at the top – IF you already completed that step).

Place the folded edge into the 1¼" circle punch and find the center (from left to right) then punch out the circle. If you like, find the center with your ruler and mark it with a pencil, first. But it's OK to “eye ball” it, too! :o)

## ☐ ACTIVITY 4: FILL CANDY BAG

Fill the cellophane bag with candy, fold the opening closed (about 1”), and staple it closed.

**IMPORTANT:** Make sure you place 2 staples - one at the far right side and one at the far left. You want to make sure the center top is free of any staples, as that is where you will be punching later!



## Assembly Instructions

*Make sure you have completed all of the prep activities before you begin assembling your project!*

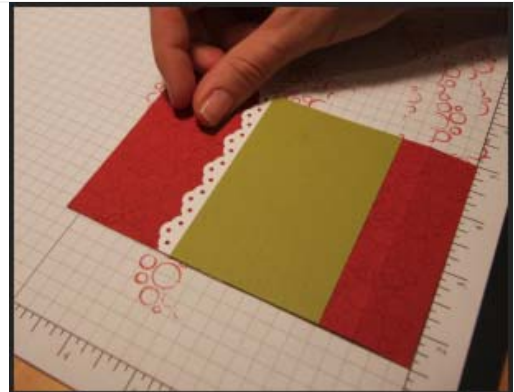
*These steps should be completed in this order!*



Using the SNAIL Adhesive, adhere the whisper white cardstock to the back (non-textured side) of the remaining piece of the 3½ x 2¼ Kiwi Kiss Textured Cardstock – making sure the eyelet edge side is showing.

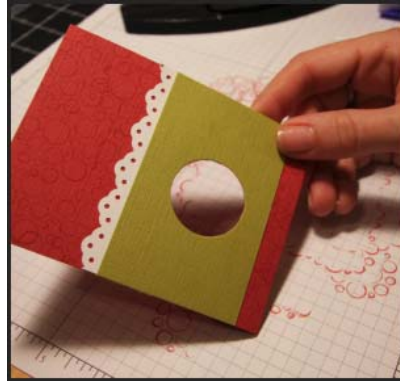
Using SNAIL Adhesive, adhere the kiwi kiss cardstock piece about 3/8” from the **score line** of the Riding Hood Red Cardstock with the punched hole. (You will be covering the hole).

**Tip:** If you like, use your ruler and pencil to measure and mark before placing.



Turn the Riding Hood Red Cardstock over, fold in the bottom piece and place it into the 1¼” punch. Line up the existing punched hole as accurately as possible and punch through the kiwi kiss & whisper white card stock.

You should once again, have your open hole:



Turn the piece back over, and adhere the Cherry Patterned paper over the Kiwi Kiss Cardstock layer – make sure to center it vertically. Adhere with SNAIL adhesive.

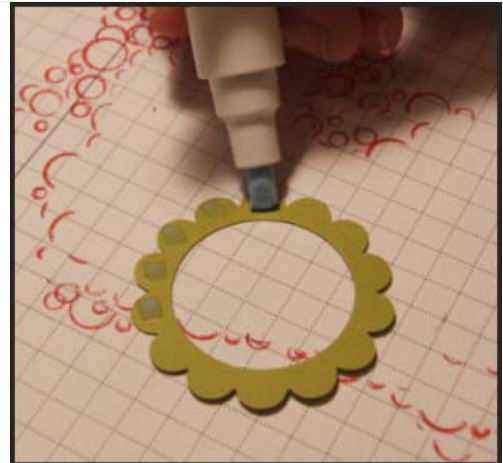
Turn the piece back over, fold in the edge and punch through the existing hole again.



Get your Kiwi Kiss flower border and turn it over so that the non-textured side faces up.

Use the 2-way glue pen to apply adhesive to the back.

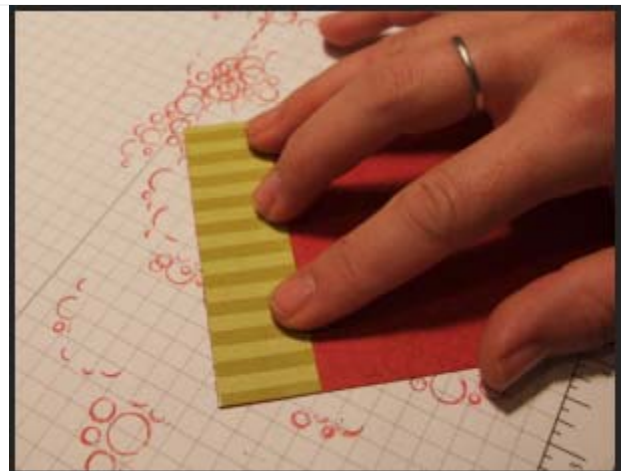
**Tip:** If the pen is dry, depress the tip a few times onto your placemat to get the glue flowing. Make sure not to do this on your project, as you may get too much glue.



Line up the flower border with the window on your assembled piece and place it.

Take the 3 ½ x 1 piece of green striped Rockabilly paper and use the SNAIL adhesive to adhere it to the top edge (*furthest from the scored edge*) of the **non-textured** side of the 3 ½ x 6 Riding Hood Red Cardstock.

After Adhering, use the Corner Rounder punch to punch off each of the corners.

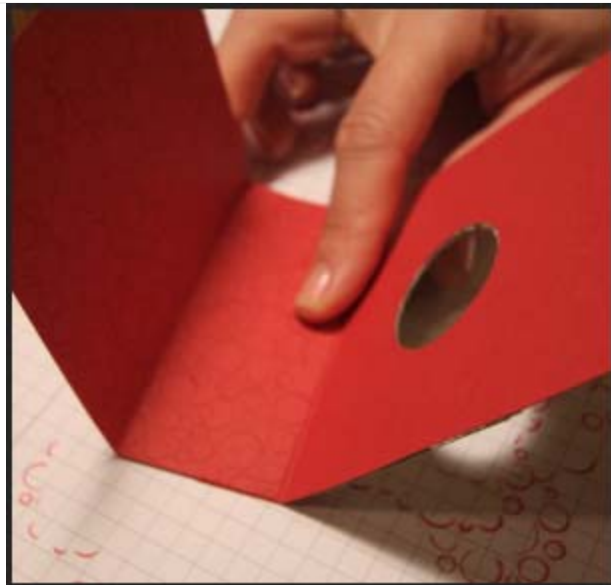


You will now adhere the 2 pieces of the treat bag together.

Place the piece with the window so that the decorated side faces down. Place a piece of sticky strip on the folded edge.

Use the bone folder and rub over the tape firmly. This will help you to lift off the red covering. And make the tape adhere better.

Remove the red covering.



Now take the folded edge of the second piece (with the non-textured side facing towards the first piece) and line its folded edge along the fold line of the piece with the sticky strip.

**Tip:** Do not touch the pieces together until they are well aligned! Sticky Strip is meant to be permanent!

Place a piece of sticky strip right underneath the adhered striped rockabilly paper on the back piece. Rub with the bone folder and remove the red covering.

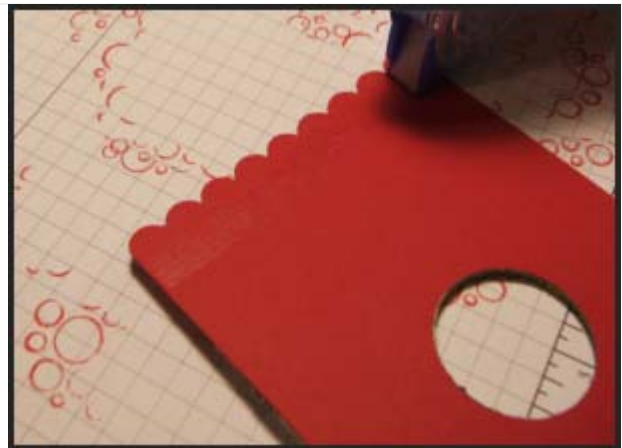






Place the candy bag on the sticky strip and press firmly.

Place some SNAIL Adhesive underneath scalloped edge of the inside of the front cover.



Close the two pieces together leaving about 1 cm of the striped green Rockabilly paper showing at the top.

Use the ¼” hole on the Crop-a-Dile tool to punch 2 holes about ¾” apart in the center/top of the bag (underneath the scallop edge).

If you like, use your ruler and pencil!



Take your 6” Kiwi Kiss Ribbon and run it through the holes and tie a double knot.

Trim the edges of the ribbon to your liking.

**Tip:** If you like, you can burn the edges to prevent fraying, or allow them to fray for a shabby chic look!

There you go! A super sweet treat bag for that special someone!
