- Score acetate sheet at 5-1/4" to create a 5 1/4" square card. **DO NOT FOLD CARD YET!** (Acetate was cut to 5 1/4" x 10-1/2")
- Stamp snowflakes from Serene Snowflakes set with StazOn™ Cotton White ink on front of the acetate card base. Use a piece of paper to create a mat along the top crease. Be careful not to smear images as acetate tends to be a little slippery. Set card base aside to dry.
- Take one of the pieces of kraft CS and stamp Dasher in Choc Chip (Do not center image - stamp slightly to the right). Using a sponge dauber to apply Platinum Shimmer paint, stamp the "Seasons Greetings" sentiment over the legs (and to the left) of Dasher. Then do the same for the smallest snowflake set and stamp over Dasher's horns (and slightly off the paper)
- Mat your stamped image with Bride Specialty Paper (white). Apply glue dots to all four corners on the back of matted image. Center on acetate card base front and attach.
- Apply glue dots directly behind the stamped image panel on the inside front of the acetate card.
- Take Bordering Blue CS and center and attach directly behind stamped image. This will be the third mat layer so take care to mat evenly.
- You may now fold your card base in half along score line.
- Take the second piece of Kraft CS and stamp "May the true spirit..." sentiment from Snow Swirled in Choc Chip. Mat with Bride Specialty Paper.
- Take matted image and attach glue dots on all 4 corners. Place your card base on the table with the front facing down. Take your matted image and center it (FACE DOWN!) on top of the Bordering Blue CS piece. Once the piece is centered, CAREFULLY close the back on the card onto it. If lined up correctly, this piece will be invisible when the card is closed.
- On the very back of the card (outside) apply glue dots behind the sentiment layer you just applied. Take Night of Navy CS and attach to acetate, being careful once more to mat evenly (the matting will appear behind the Bordering Blue layer when viewing the card from the front.
- Use your 1/16" hole punch to punch a hole as far as it will reach along the crease of the card - on both sides! Thread a piece of silver elastic cord and tie a bow at the top.
